

# IOWA CITY *Kickers*

## 7<sup>th</sup> Annual *Spring Fling Tournament* May 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> Schedule (Revised 5/4/10)

### Important Notes (PLEASE READ):

- 1) Please look at schedules carefully and be at least 15 minutes early for your games.
- 2) First team listed is home team.
- 3) During pool play teams will be awarded 3 points for a win, 1 point for each goal up to 3 goals, 1 point for a tie, and 1 point for a shutout (maximum of 7 points/game).
- 4) The four teams with the most points from pool play in each league will advance to the championship round on May 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>. All other teams will also play one game on May 22<sup>nd</sup> or 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- 5) Score will be kept by both coaches from each team. The winning coach (or home team in event of a tie in pool play) will report their scores at either of the Concession Stands. Any disputes must be directed to the Spring Fling Director. **IF SCORES ARE NOT REPORTED, NEITHER TEAM WILL RECEIVE POINTS.**
- 6) The second weekend schedule is tentative and based on standings after first weekend. Final schedules for the final weekend for these leagues will be posted to the website by Tuesday, May 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 7) In the event of a tie in standings, tiebreakers will be decided using the following sequence of criteria:
  - a) Head to head competition, b) Best goal differential (goals scored minus goals allowed) with a maximum of a 3 goal differential per game; losing teams will receive a negative goal differential, c) Fewest goals allowed, d) Best regular season record, and e) Coin toss.
- 8) For championship round games, the team with the highest point total from previous play will be home team.
- 9) All rules and game lengths will be the same as those used in the spring season for pool play games. They will also be the same for the championship games with the exception that two 5 minute overtime periods will be played in event of a tie. The first team to score will win the game in either overtime period. If after both overtime periods end the game is still tied, then the outcome will be decided by penalty kicks as per FIFA rules (starting with 5 per team).
- 10) The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams for each league and flight will receive individual trophies.
- 11) Please emphasize to your players, parents and coaches, that we expect the highest standards of sportsmanship throughout the event. Kickers reserves the right to penalize and sanction teams based on unsportsmanlike behavior from players, coaches, and parents.
